The older teens wanted the incoming freshmen to learn from and avoid some of the dramas they'd experienced. Now, those scenarios are told in a performance where the teen audience is asked to think through and imagine what they would do in the face of challenges like bullying, texting/sexting, first kiss, social media, and mental health.
